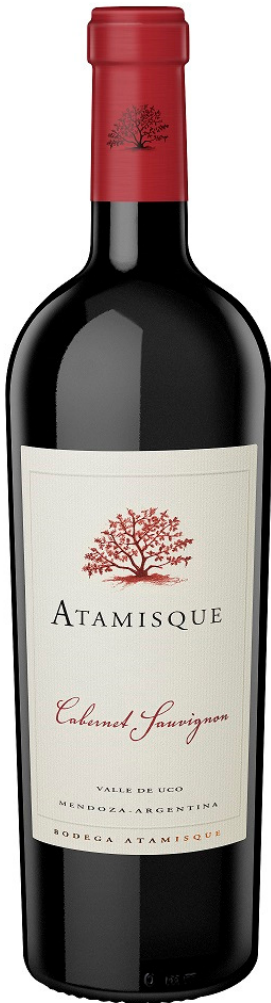

Tasting Notes

Red fruit jam, with notes dark minerals, cigar box and hints of black pepper. Full-bodied and well-structured with smooth round tannins. Mature red fruits, spices, dark chocolate and coffee, lingering in a perfectly balanced finish.

Elaboration Process

Atamisque Cabernet Sauvignon comes from a single vineyard located in Vistaflores, Mendoza, one of the best wine-growing regions in Argentina. The vineyard stands at 3,600 feet high, enjoying a privileged sun exposure and cool temperatures that allow the grapes to have a perfect ripening. The grapes are hand picked and selected in a sorting table. The winery is designed based on gravity-flow winemaking techniques. Temperature controlled fermentation is done in small stainless-steel tanks. Finally, the wine is aged in new French oak barrels (Taransud & Demptons) for 14 months before bottling.

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
