## **Tasting Notes**

Golden color with shades of emerald green. Delicate aromas of apple, pineapple and honey, with light hints of toasted caramel. It is full-bodied, elegant, intense and well-balance. Vibrant acidity and sharp mineral notes. Pair with any kind of seafood, salads, poultry and soft cheese. It is also a great aperitif.

## **Elaboration Process**

Catalpa Chardonnay single vineyard comes from the Alto Tupungato area, one of the best winegrowing regions within Mendoza, Argentina. The vineyard is located at 4,430 feet high, enjoying a privileged sun exposure and cool temperatures that allow the grapes to have a perfect ripening. The grapes are hand-picked and selected in a sorting table. Temperature-controlled fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks. About 40% of the wine is aged in new French oak barrels for 10 months. The rest stays in the tanks and is blended again with the oak-aged portion before bottling.
