



**Celler Ronadelles** is a small, family owned and run winery that lies in the foothills of the impressive Montsant mountain range.

Founder **Jaume Giral** started the winery in 2002 to make modern, elegant and innovative wines with a small, dedicated team who care for the vines, carefully preselecting and handpicking the grapes, always respecting the lunar calendar and integrating traditional and modern methods of winegrowing.

Winemaker **Eva Prim** has been at Celler Ronadelles since 2008. Her enthusiasm and unconditional love for wine has led Celler Ronadelles to the highest quality levels.

Biodynamic farming has much in common with other organic approaches, using manure and compost, and avoiding artificial chemicals. The biodynamic approach includes the use of fermented herbal and mineral preparations as compost additives, and the use of an astronomical sowing and planting calendar.

### FLOR DEL MONTSANT Red 2015

**Denomination of Origin:** D.O. Montsant

**Winemaker:** Eva Prim



**Blend and Tasting Notes:** 80% Grenache, 20% Carignan. Bright and ripe red fruit aroma with intense well balanced spices and light mineral hints. Expressive, filling the palate with balanced fruit and mineral flavors. Gentle and elegant tannic structure with a smooth mouthfeel. Pair with a wide range of tapas, particularly with “pa amb tomàquet”- Catalan style rustic bread with fresh tomato and olive oil.

**Estate Vineyards:** Our Grenache comes from the Les Verdenes vineyard, planted on 1979 on clay and chalk soils. Our Carignan is from the La Vedrenya vineyard, planted on 1974 on calcareous soil. Both vineyards yield 1.5kg to 2kg per plant and have 2500 plants per hectare.

**Harvest and Winemaking Notes:** Biodynamic Wine, grown according to the astronomical sowing and planting calendar. Hand-harvested respecting the lunar calendar in 15kg bins and cooled to 41F. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at 77F. Punch downs during maceration for 20-25 days and malolactic with fine lees. Slow reduced pressure pressing.

*Each and every one of our wines is the result of hundreds of decisions taken in the vineyard and the cellar.
