Les Vins Bonhomme: Les Vins Bonhomme makes wines from across Spain with a fabulous team of winemakers and small family owners. We aim to transport you with each sip to the most interesting corners of Spain. This voyage is made through beautiful and harmonious differences, achieving a unity in the wines that equals their makers and terroir.

Bodegas Rafael Cambra: One of the most enigmatic and innovative young winemakers in Spain. Rafael has spent much of his life in the vineyards at his family's renowned root-stock nursery. After studying and apprentice work in France, he returned to his native Valencia, where he bought a 40-year-old vineyard of Monastrell vines and started his winery using his philosophy that quality wine is made in the vineyard by creating sustainable harmony with in it. "Grapes are like a rough diamond, you have to shape it, polish it, but in no case modify it".

El Bon Homme: El Bon Homme is a special project that Rafael does for a personal Canadian friend, Maria Bon Homme. There are 3 different labels representing the qualities of El Bon Homme (a good friend): Journey, imagination, and passion.

Tasting notes: Dark cherry color, black fruits on the nose, streaks of red cherries on the palate with a smooth clean texture, a tinge of plum and vibrant freshness. Medium-bodied with subtle French oak adding length and structure to the finish.

Appellation: Valencia Grapes: 50% Monastrell, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon

Soil: Sandy Elevation: 2132 feet

Vine Age: Monastrell 15 yrs, Cabernet Suavignon 25 yrs

Vineyard practice: Sustainable including dry farming Yield: 1.4 tons per acre

Harvest Dates: End of September by hand

Fermentation: Fermentation in small stainless-steel tanks of 5000 liters. Maceration

at 23 degrees C for 8 days.

Aging: 4-6 months in 1-2 year used 225 L French oak barrels

pH: 3.6 RS: 2.5 grams per liter Alc: 13.6% UPC: 7 50428 21217 1

Valencia: is the name of the autonomous community (state), a province within the state, a DO, and the 3rd largest city in Spain. The vineyard and winery are based in Fontanars dels Alforins, a small village of about 800 inhabitants located South of Valencia and N. of Alicante, 2100 feet above sea level. A dry, inland Mediterranean climate where vines flourish in harmony with other crops such as almonds, olive trees and grains.
