



Delgado Zuleta: Founded in 1744, Bodegas Delgado Zuleta is the oldest sherry bodega in Sanlúcar de Barrameda. The bodega is still a small boutique winery, located in the coastal village of Sanlúcar de Barrameda, at the mouth of the Guadalquivir River on the Atlantic coast.

Lola is the winemaking collaboration between Delgado Zuleta and Bodegas Aragonesas in the D.O. Campo de Borja where the grapes are sourced.

Vintage: 2021

Grapes: 50% Viura & 50% Chardonnay

Appellation: DO Campo de Borja

Soils: Lime stone and iron rich clay

Tasting notes: Fresh fruity aromas with white flower notes. A rich palate that is lively and young with a sweet voluminous flavor of tree ripened white nectarines and peaches with plenty of acid and a touch of bubbles to keep it light and refreshing.

Winemaking Notes: Lightly pressed followed by racking for a clean juice. Fermentation happens in stainless-steel tanks using selected yeasts at temperature control. The blend is created after fermentation and bottling is done monthly to insure its freshness.

Campo de Borja DO: Located in the autonomous region of Aragón, that is nestled against the Pyrenées Mountains surrounded by the prime wine regions of Catalonia Navarra and Rioja. Viticulture in the region dates back to the Romans, DO status was granted in 1980. The high elevation and iron and limestone rich soils set this region apart.
