

Magnum Carlos Lucas Vinhos was founded in 2011. Based at Quinta do Ribeiro Santo, winemaker Carlos Lucas produces wines from D.O.C. Dão, D.O.C Douro and D.O.C. Alentejo. Each bottle reflects his passion and dedication to show the best of each of these regions through wines that are true to their terroir, tradition and native Portuguese grape varieties. Carlos has a profound respect for the environment and uses sustainable agriculture principles and organic products in his winemaking.



Carlos Lucas begun making wines in 1993, after earning his DAA in Viticulture and Enology from IHEV at Montpellier, France. In addition to multiple Portugues regions, Carlos has made wines in Piedmont and and Priorat. He was awarded "2007 Portuguese Winemaker of the Year" by the prestigious "Revista de Vinhos".



D.O.C. Dão

The D.O.C. Dão region (named after the Dão river) is one of the oldest Wine Regions of Portugal, located in central Portugal in a mountainous region ranging from 400 to 700 m above sea level. This region has its reference point at the mountain "Serra da Estrela", the highest in mainland Portugal's. The wines are strongly influenced by granitic soils and the forests with pines, eucalyptus and oak trees surrounding the vineyards.

D.O.C. Douro

The Douro region is the world's oldest wine region. The "Alto Douro" Wine Region is part of a small elite classified as World Heritage by UNESCO for its natural beauty and rich patrimony. It is the combination of the qualities of soil, climate and the hard work of the man that makes this wine region unique. The grapes come from several parcels of vineyards, planted in shale soil and arranged in terraces.
