



HINOJOSA

(ee - no - hosa)

In 1962 Don Silvestre Hinojosa planted 122 hectares in the Alto Valle de Uco (High Uco Valley). The wine making tradition and spirit of Don Silvestre are still alive with the third generation of Bodegas y Viñedos Hinojosa. Today, Hinojosa shares the same goal of producing excellent wines inspired by the purest and most noble elements of nature.

The stony and sandy ground of Tunuyán, Mendoza, allows excellent drainage of underground water coming from ice melting off the Andes Mountains. At almost 4,000 feet above sea level, at the foothills of the Andes, in one of the best wine regions of Mendoza, Argentina, Hinojosa's wines are born with a perfect environment for slow grape ripeness and a large temperature amplitude between day and night.

“H” Malbec

Malbec Reserve - Aromas of plums and mature cherries, with hints of violets and black currants. Full-bodied with great fruit intensity and elegant balance. Velvety mature tannins and notes of dark chocolate and tobacco. Uco Valley is one of the best regions in the world for Malbec.

HINOJOSA

Malbec - Aromas of blueberries, plums and violets. Medium-bodied and well-balanced. Good acidity, flavors of boysenberries, vanilla and hints of tobacco.

Tempranillo - Intense red fruit aromas with hints of blackberry and plum. It is well-balanced and medium-bodied, with intense red fruit acidity. Tobacco, dark chocolate and notes of spices in the finish.

DON SILVESTRE

Chardonnay - Golden color, bright and clear with hints of emerald. Persistent aroma of pineapple and vanilla, and a delicate, creamy mouthfeel.

Malbec - Complex aromas of red fruits, plums and leather notes. Round, medium-bodied and well-structured, with soft tannins and an elegant finish.

Tempranillo - Aromas of mature cherries, blackberries and smooth notes of dark chocolate. Medium-bodied, good acidity and exotic spices.
