**Quinta das Arcas:** In 1985 Esteve Montiero decided to turn his successful family business of grape growing into winemaking. Today the Monteiro family is the one of the top viticulturists and wine producers in the Vinho Verde Region. Dedicating themselves to producing quality grapes and wines with a focus on sustainability and modern wine making.

**Tasting notes:** Light pink rosé color. Fresh young aromas of strawberries and raspberries mixed with currant and lime drops. The fine structure and acidity are balanced by more of those strawberry and raspberry notes that is all carried by that classic Vinho Verde fizz.

**D.O.C. Vinho Verde:** D.O.C. Vinho Verde: Located along the Atlantic coast in northern Portugal, Vinho Verde lies between the city of Oporto and the northern border with Spain. Vinho Verde translates to 'green wine', referring to the appearance of the region which is lush and green thanks to high precipitation and influence from the Atlantic Ocean. The area is mostly known for its light and refreshing white wines but also produces elegant and floral whites, rosé, reds, and sparkling wines in diverse styles. Wine has been produced in this region for over 2,000 years since the Romans brought vines to the area during the Roman Empire.
