History: A story of pharmacist turned winemaker; Rodriguez de Vera started making wine with his family's vineyards at home as a hobby, but hailing from 6 generations of viticulturist, it wasn't long for this hobby to turn into a passion and after completing his Masters of Wine, Pepe finally realized his dream to fulltime winemaking.

Sopla Levante: The 30ha of vineyards for Sopla Levante Moscatel are located within the Parque Natural de Mata so the vineyards must be worked in a natural way. Yeast is collected using clay vessels filled with crushed grapes placed in the vineyard.

Tasting notes Lemon yellow color with a presence of citrus fruit, lemon, saline and Mediterranean herbs on the nose. Medium bodied with medium + acid, citrus fruits and more of those Mediterranean herbs with a saline finish. Drink now through 2026.

Winemaker: Rodriguez de Vera

Appellation: Grown in the Natural Park of La Mata, Alicante, Spain

Varietals: 100% Moscatel de Alejandra

Soil: Sand **Vine Age:** 60 years **Production:** 9,000 btls total

Fermentation: After harvest grapes are put in a fridge for 2-4 weeks. This helps evaporate water, increasing flavors and acid in the grapes with no needing to add additional tartaric acid. Aged in stainless steel for 6 months.

PH: 3.73 **RS:** <0.2 mg/L **Alc:** 12.5% **So2:** 17mg/l **UPC:** 841606368556

Parque Natural de Mata: Located in the province of Alicante, Mata is part of a triangle of wetlands crucial to the biological cycles of numerous species who use it both for migration and their nesting/wintering. The park is made up of two saltwater lagoons Mata and Torrevieja and are separated by a fold in the earth's crust called an anticline. A canal leading to the ocean joins the two lagoons, mostly defining the area with saline habitats like the lagoons and bright pink salt flats, but also include pine forests, ravines and boulevards that carry fresh water, and agriculture, including vineyards that host some of the most important grape varieties of the region: Moscatel de Alejandra and Merseguera.
